Reconnecting and strengthening their relationship with the Waikato River through the restoration of the traditional waka access will enable ongoing activities and traditional cultural ceremonies to continue at this location. 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Waikato Tainui *	Customary activities and resources - the project will support local marae's aspirations to undertake customary activities, particularly those associated with Waka. At times the site is also used for Hari Tuupaapaku - the transportation of human remains and the accompanying funeral ceremonies to Taupiri Mountain. Improvements to the site, including the waka tauranga, will support safe launching and use of waka and create a formalised area that can support ceremonial, customary, recreational, competition and sporting purposes. Access - the project will improve access to the significant cultural site and will support Waikato-Tainui and other local marae's aspirations to undertake customary activities. Currently, there are no suitable locations between Huntly and Mercer/Tuakau Bridge where a range of cultural activities can take place. Significant sites - The waka access is a site of significance returned to Waikato-Tainui under the Waikato River Settlement. The location touches on many elements of the river settlement which includes the return of ancestral lands to the people, the use of the site by the people for customary purposes, access for the community to the Waikato River and the restoration of the site.
